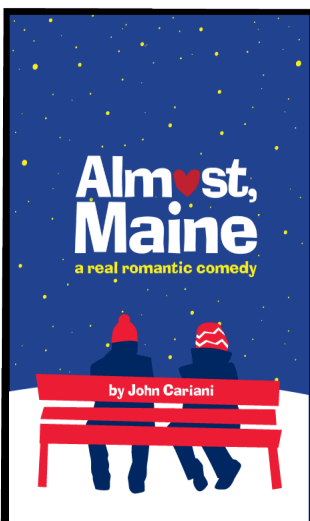
From the Desk of Jerry Jackman-
